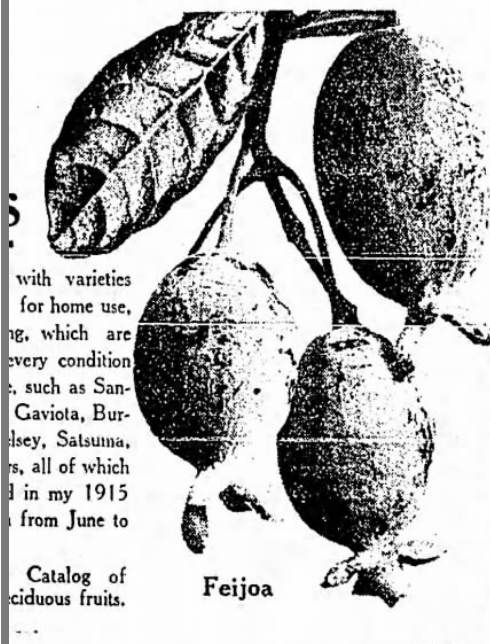

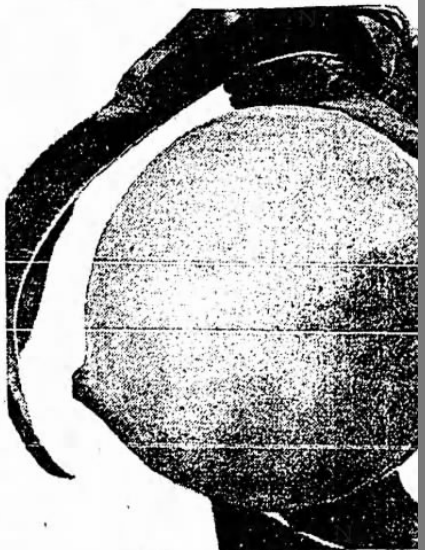


Feijoa
